



2022 Annual Report

Property: *There were no property projects during 2022, although we did begin the process for the next round of 5YA, which will start in the middle of next year.*

Curriculum: *We've continued to pursue the best learning outcomes for students in the core areas of Reading, Writing and Maths. 2022 saw further COVID interruptions during term 1 and then again during term 4 when we had a lot of cases rearing their head within our school again. It created a lot of student absenteeism along with a number of kaiako having to self-isolate for a week. No doubt, all this had an impact on academic progress and achievement but it's very pleasing to see our school was still able to maintain relatively good results.*

EEO: *All efforts have been made to ensure that all staff have had equal opportunities and that there has been no discrimination against any member due to gender or beliefs. No new positions were advertised during 2022.*

Kiwisport: *All funds from Kiwisport were spent over the year. Some examples of use were; PE gear, class camps that focused upon the Key Comps, Sports teams participating in local competitions, and contributions to class trips.*

Governance: *We had several changes this year due to members standing down due to their child leaving Walton at the end of last year. Jackie Lugton and Ross McIntyre stood down at our February meeting for this reason. We went through the due process of filling these two casual vacancies, which led to Josh Daley & Rob Bekker joining the board. Stu Muckle was also co-opted at this stage to bring our members to five (Sue Cummings as Chair, Jason Suited, Josh Daley, Rob Bekker & Stu Muckle.)*

There were triannual elections during the year, and our school went through the election process (Returning Officer was Mandy Allan).
